Ty's songs have become favorites to many country music fans. He has achieved 8 top 40 hits to date including "Should've Asked Her Faster"; still a hotly requested top 3 hit. More recently his self-penned "Texans Hold'em" remained #1 for 8 weeks in a row on the Texas Music Charts. A wide variety of Ty's music is currently played frequently on the GARTH Sirrus channel and is rewarded with rave reviews by the Garth Fans.



Ty's debut self-titled album was produced by Garth Fundis on RCA records. This album was honored with rave reviews and generated several singles including the top three hit "Should've Asked Her Faster". For the second time in his life, someone with the name Garth played a significant role in fulfilling his musical aspirations. Songs include: Redneck Son, Smoke In Her Eyes, Should've Asked Her Faster, Her Only Bad Habit, You'll Find Somebody New, A Swing Like That, New Faces In The Fields, The Blues Ain't News To Me, It's Lonesome Everywhere and Is That You.



The second album in the RCA series titled "Two Ways to Fall" was produced by James Stroud and Byron Gallimore. This was a more edgy gathering of down to earth country favorites. "There were songs on this record that really spoke to me and my upbringing. I love that my fans tend to hear the same messages and are drawn to similar stories." Charted singles including Irresistible You and All of The Above. Songs include: It Starts With L, Two Ways To Fall, I'll Take Today, Never Say Never, The Last Dance, Kick Back, Irresistible You, Backslider's Prayer, All Of The Above, and Sure.



A leap to Capitol records gave Ty the opportunity to craft music with his old friend Garth Brooks once again. "This is the most fun I've ever had making music" says Ty. "I had the pleasure to rejoin my old friend and actually make old dreams into a reality." Garth and Ty spent more than a year developing a list of true clasic country favorites that would make George Straight proud. Singles included "I'd Rather Have Nothin" and "I Drove Her To Dallas". Songs include: My Baby No Esta Aqui No More, She's Gonna Miss Me When He's Gone, She Don't Care About Me, I Drove Her To Dallas, Blame It On Mexico, Forever, Too Many Highways, Collect From Wichita, I'd Rather Have Nothing, I Knew I Loved You, Traveling Soldier and a bonus track duet with Steve Wariner of Should've Asked Her Faster.



Years of traveling and hundreds of performances later, Ty realized that his children would only be small once. This mostly self-penned album was crafted in his home office between (and sometimes during) baseball and football games and other various school activities. "I really let the Oklahoma in me hang out on this one" says Ty. "I had a blast writing with my buddies and I'm really proud of how it all worked out in the mix." Ty learned a lot to as this album released on his own label called Triple T Records. Charted singles included Redneck Anthem, Texans Hold'em (8 weeks at #1) and The Perfect Girl. Songs include: Love Is Stronger, Perfect Girl, Texans Hold'em, Club Paradise, Nothing But Love, Redneck Anthem, Stick To Your Guns, The NRA Song, It Must Be Colorado and Living The Dream.
